HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY:

To support our Health & Safety policy statement we are committed to carry out the following duties:

- Undertake regular risk assessment of the practice premises and all activities undertaken by Hevva
- Create a safe environment by putting health & safety measures in place as identified by the assessment
- Ensure that all members are given the appropriate level of teaching by regularly assessing individual ability dependant on age, maturity and development
- Ensure that all members are aware of, understand and follow Hevva's health & safety policy
- Ensure that normal operating procedures and emergency operating procedures are in place and known by all members
- Provide access to adequate first aid facilities
- Report any injuries or accidents sustained during any activity or whilst on practice premises
- Ensure that the implementation of the policy is reviewed regularly and monitored for effectiveness.

- Take reasonable care for your own health & safety and that of others who may be affected by what you do or not do
- Co-operate on health & safety issues
- Ensure that you participate in warm-up activities
- Not interfere with or misuse anything provided for your health, safety or welfare.
